### WHY IS THE REFERENDUM NEEDED?

State and local funding for Rochester Public Schools has not kept pace with the rising cost of educating our kids. The perpupil funding that our public schools receive from local property taxes is well below the state average. Our school district has worked to keep costs under control, cutting its budget by \$28.6 million since 2001 and spending down its rainy day fund.

## WITHOUT ADDITIONAL FUNDING

- Budget cuts would be necessary every year through 2019-20 and beyond.
- Teachers and other staff would be cut -- a total of 223 full-time positions through 2019-20.
- Class sizes would increase and academic programs and classes would be cut.

### WHAT WOULD A **YES VOTE** MEAN?

- Local per-pupil revenue for Rochester schools would be raised to the state average.
- The school district would be able to maintain current class sizes, academic programs and staffing through the 2019-20 school year.
